Larch is a popular softwood decking and siding species in many European countries. The Western Canadian subspecies grows in cold, high elevation climates creating tight and straight grain with a Janka hardness rating of 830 - making it one of the hardest softwood in North America. Knots are common but small. Color ranges from yellow to a medium reddish brown. It takes stains and paint well. If left untreated, Larch will silver. It is rated moderately durable and will stay beautiful for many years.


KD 5/4 x 6 Western Larch Decking

Features

- Product of center cut rough blanks to minimize sapwood
- Graded as high line appearance product
- Carefully dried
- Net dimensions 1" x 5.375" with .25" radius
- Tallies naturally heaviest to 16ft
- Paperwrapped units @ 128pcs

Installation tips

- Install with heart side up
- Fasten with #10 2.5" Stainless steel fasteners for face screwing
- Drill pilot holes at ends
- Seal end cuts as with hardwoods
